RQR Travel Award – 2018 Competition

The RQR is pleased to announce its 2018 Travel Award Competition for awards of a maximum of \$ 400 to cover costs associated with attendance at a national or international meeting to promote scientific exchanges. For meetings held in the province of Quebec, the maximum amount is \$ 200.

ADMISSION CRITERIA:

- The meeting must occur between January 1st and December 31st, 2018 and a limit of 2 travel grants per laboratory has been set;
- The candidate must give an oral or poster presentation at the meeting;
- The research director must be a member or collaborator of the RQR;
- Only one travel award per year per trainee;
- The meeting cannot take place in the city where the candidate lives;
- The RQR Symposium does not meet the criteria for this competition.

If the Travel grant is awarded, the following documents will be required:

- Proof of registration to the meeting;
- Proof that your abstract has been accepted for an oral or poster presentation.

Students or postdoctoral fellows can apply by sending the registration form to charlene.rico@umontreal.ca.

The deadline to apply is March 16, 2018.
