RQR Scholarships competition: Summer 2015

The RQR announces a summer scholarship competition directed only to undergraduate trainees. The summer internship must be performed under the direction of a RQR researcher. Scholarships of \$2,500 are offered and are nonrenewable.

The following rules apply for this contest:

- Maximum of 2 scholarships per researcher.
- The student is not eligible if he/she is a recipient of a government scholarship (NSERC, FRQNT, CIHR, etc.) or a CSR scholarship.
- The student is not eligible if his/her director of research has not completed the annual update of their web page on the RQR website.

Application will be evaluated according the following criteria:

Criteria	Weight
Transcripts	40 %
Awards	10 %
Environment	5 %
Project	25 %
Presentations	5 %
Aspirations	5 %
Involvement and leadership	10 %
